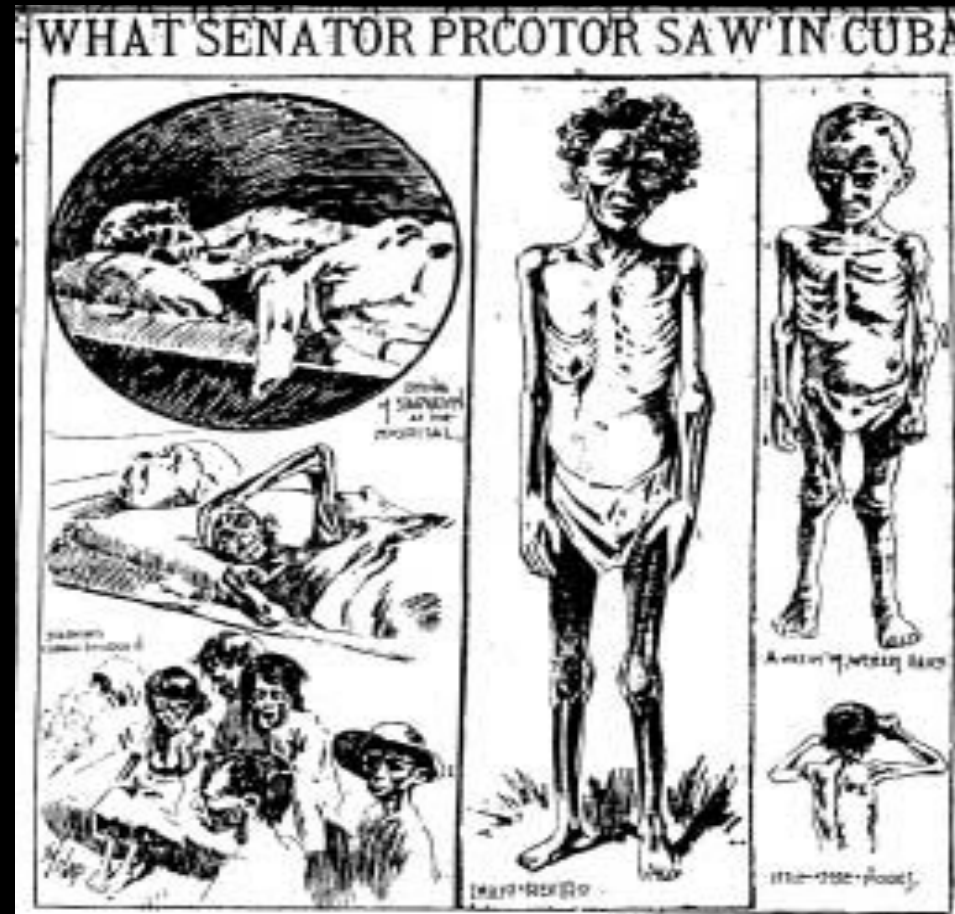

Causes of the Spanish-American War

- Cuba was still a colony of Spain into the late 1800's
- Cuban people began fighting for independence
- Stories of **cruel treatment of Cubans** began to reach the United States

- Yellow Journalism
- Sensational news stories – sometimes exaggerated
- Sinking of the U.S.S. Maine caused many to call for War

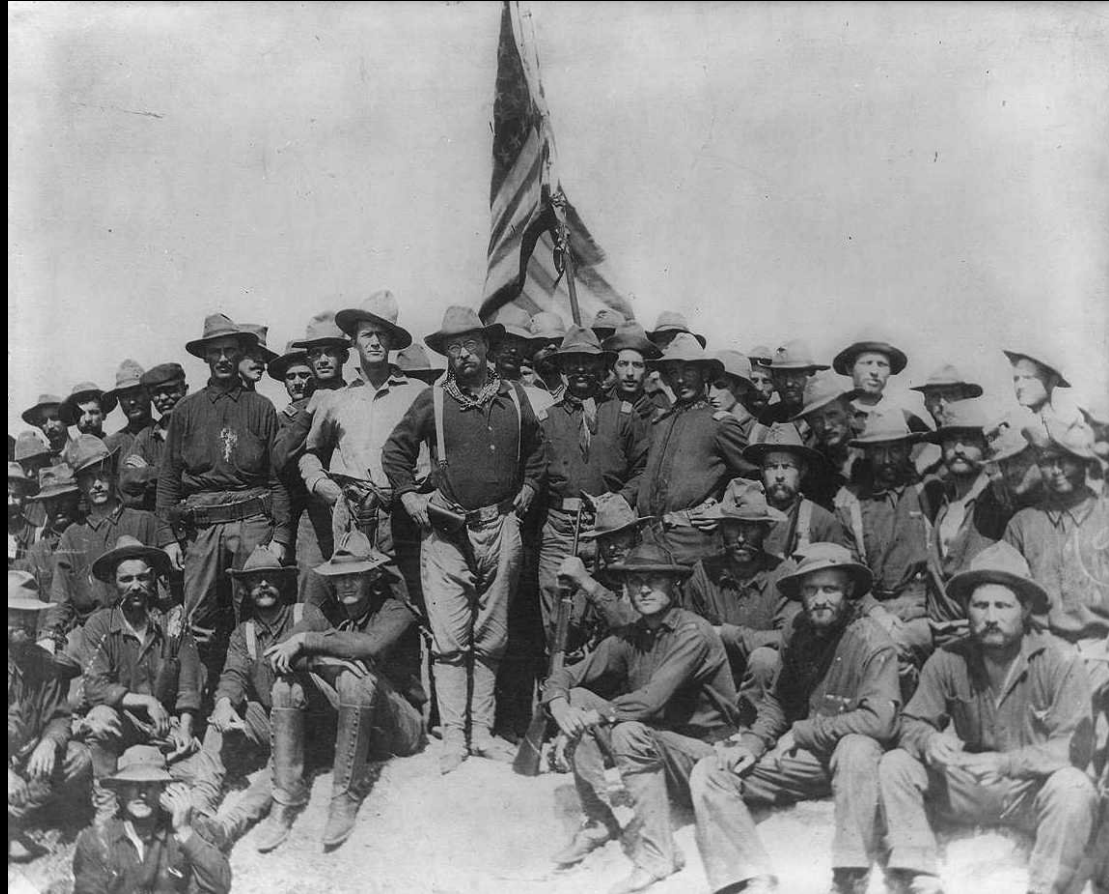

Fighting Spain

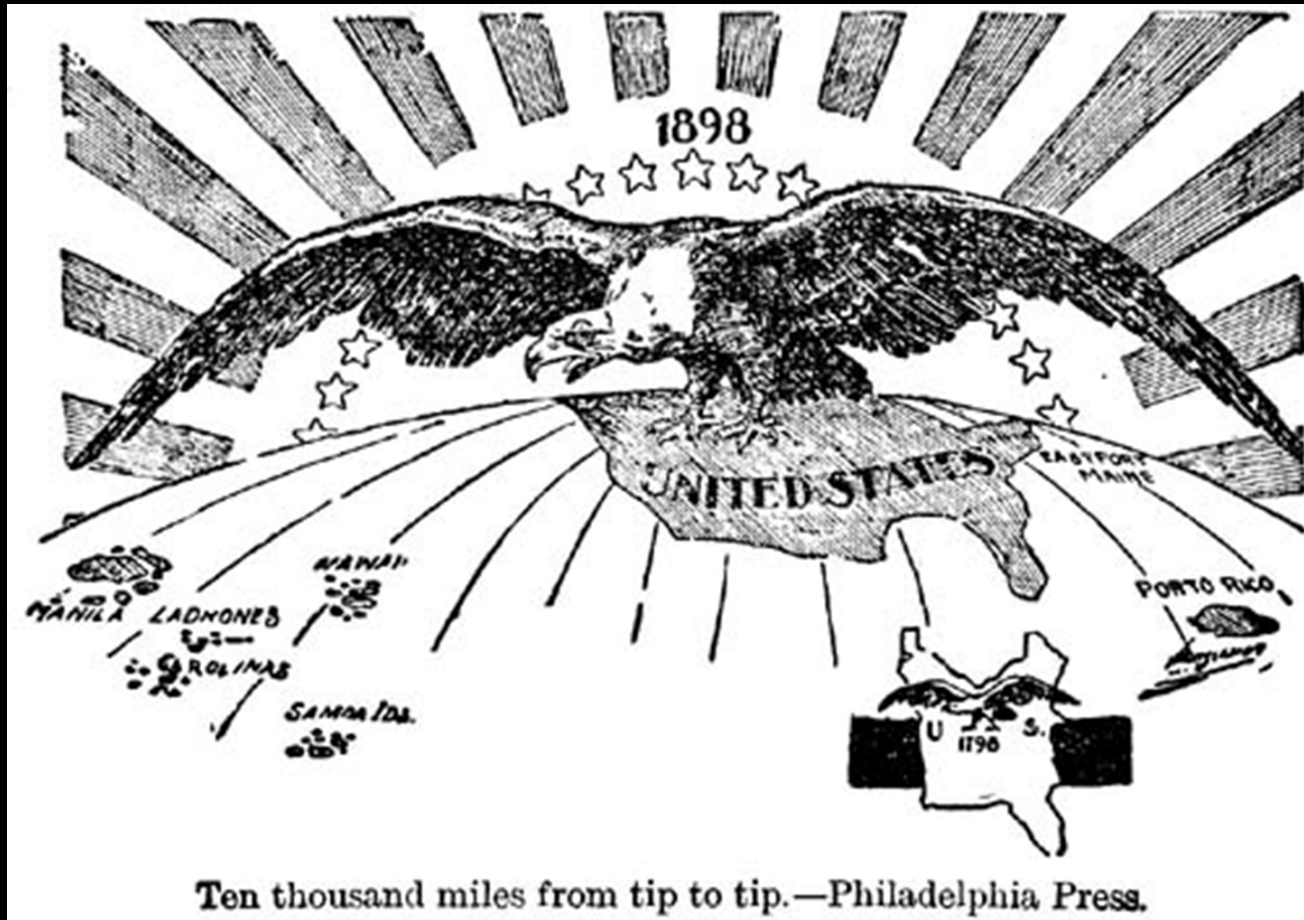
- Two Fronts of battle:

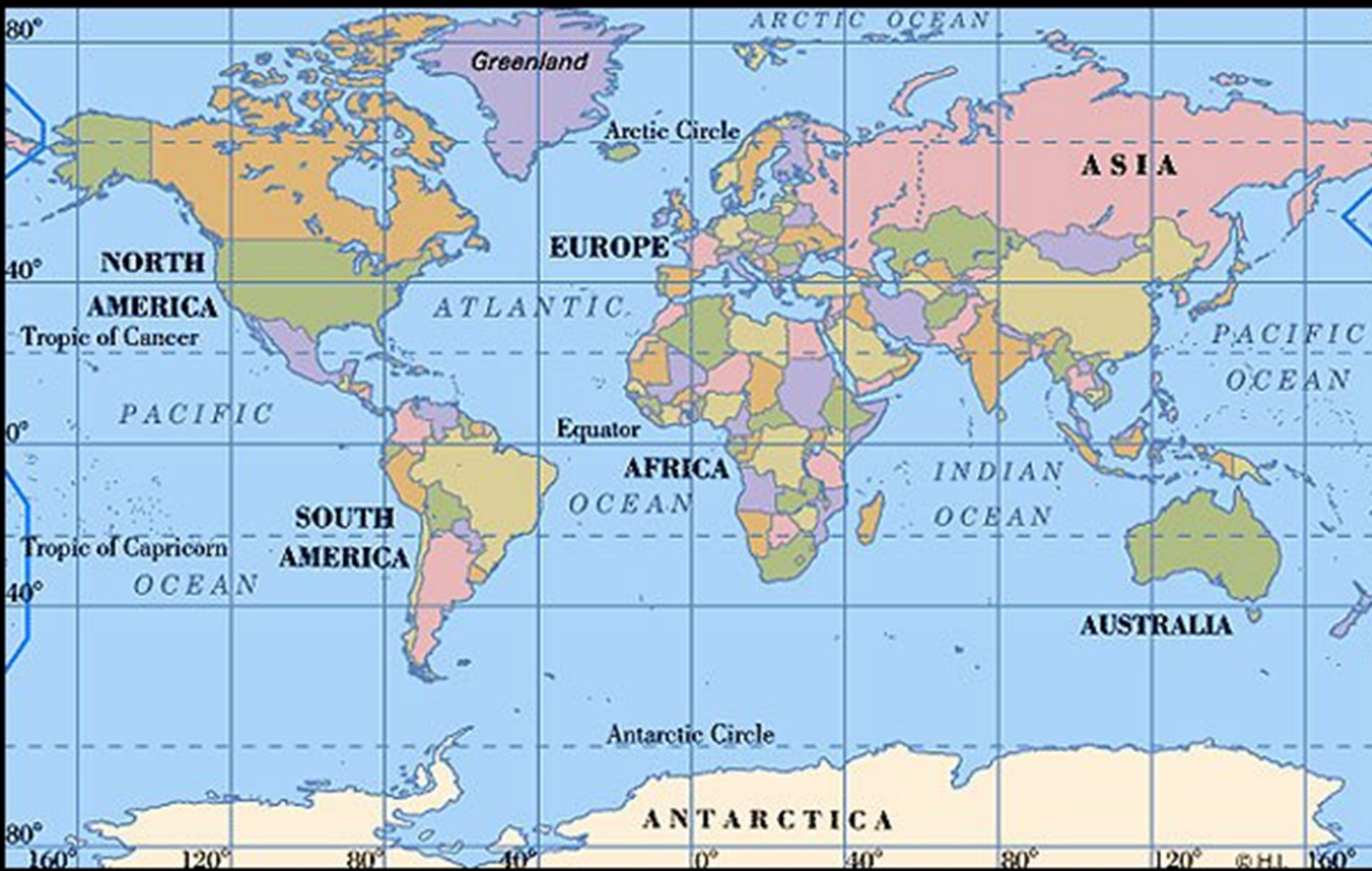
War Ends – The Results

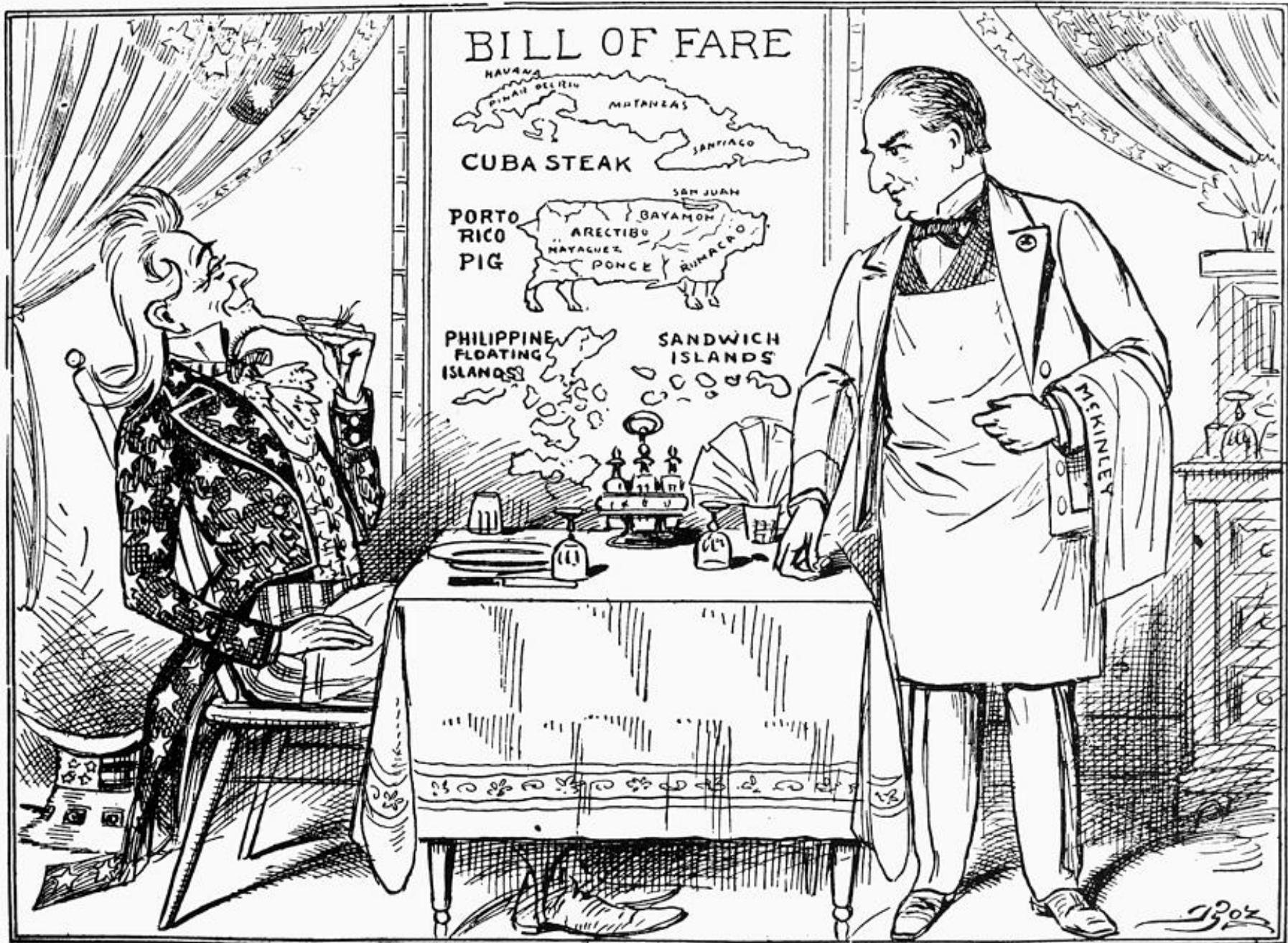
- Armistice Aug. 1898 and Treaty of Paris Dec. 1898
- America gains **Guam, Puerto Rico, (and the Philippines)**
- Cuba became a “protectorate” of the United States
