
A Call to join the U.S. Armed Forces

In May 1917 Congress passed the Selective Service Act, which required men of all races between the ages of 21 and 30 to register to be drafted into the armed forces. Eventually about 2.8 million Americans were drafted. About 2 million more volunteered.
