The Constitutional Convention

- Met in Philadelphia in May 1787
- Original plan = <u>revise</u> the Articles of Confederation
- By July 1787, <u>55 delegates</u> were present for 13 states
- Meetings kept secret Why?
- Washington elected president of the Convention, where each state had one vote
- Majority rule was used to make decisions why not unanimous rule?


Washington presides over the Convention
