
Don't Copy A Conservative Comeback

- Ronald Reagan wins in 1980 by a narrow margin
- Famous quips: "A recession is when your neighbor loses his job. A depression is when you lose yours. And recovery is when Jimmy Carter loses his."
- Only 52.6% of voters went to the polls – Why?
- <u>Major goals:</u>
- Less government
- Lower taxes
- Traditional values




Ronald Reagan 1981-1989

President Ronald Reagan's Supply-Side Economics (Trickle-Down)



<u>Reaganomics</u>

- <u>Tax Cuts</u> = Supply-side economics (AKA "Trickle Down")
- <u>Budget cuts</u> Social spending Who is most affected??
- Increase in Defense Spending





Effects of Reaganomics

- Increased <u>national deficit</u> WHY??
- Increased poverty and homelessness
- De-regulated economy where businesses and corporations grew more powerful
- Some economic growth (mid 1980's) but more serious recessions followed – Bush has to try clean that up!










George H.W. Bush

- Campaign slogan= "Read my lips: NO NEW TAXES"
- Fails!
- <u>Deep recession</u> leads to increased taxes
- Bush doesn't win reelection, mostly due to economic troubles
