

### Homework Rubric (Total of 10 Points)

<b>Completion</b>	Homework is 100% complete. It is clear that the student answered every question very well.	Homework is 70% complete. The student answered most of the questions well.	Homework is 30% complete. The student answered some of the questions.	No homework was turned in.
<b>Student Work</b>	Student work is thorough, clear, and had no spelling or grammatical errors. Answers contained 3-5 sentences. Good or excellent thesis statements or topic sentences for all answers.	Student shows an adequate amount of work for each answer, few spelling or grammatical errors. Fewer than 3 sentences per answer. Weak thesis statements for some or most answers.	Student shows some work, but it is inadequate. Many spelling or grammatical errors. Answer was 1 sentence or included incomplete sentences. No thesis statements or topic sentences are included.	Student shows no work.
<b>Accuracy</b>	Homework is 100% accurate, included many relevant facts, and plenty of information from the textbook or documents (where applicable).	Homework is 70% accurate with some relevant facts and some information from the textbook or documents (where applicable).	Homework is 30% accurate with few relevant facts and little information from the textbook or documents (where applicable).	All answers are incorrect.
<b>Format</b>			Student wrote neatly or typed the assignment, included the full heading, number, and the title of the assignment. Student numbered each question and included the original questions.	Student did not follow the homework format.

**Late Homework** will receive **half credit** for the original score.

*Example A:* If student receives a 10 but HW was late, the final grade for the assignment is 5.

*Example B:* If student receives an 8 but HW is late, the final grade for the assignment is a 4.
